Pricing: Free

Operation: Kimberley-wide with service provision. Morrkul is a joint venture of Waardi Corporation and KPP Business Development and was initially funded from Woodside royalties. In 2017, Morrkul commenced delivering the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development's (DPIRD) Aboriginal Procurement Advisory Service across regional WA. This program is currently complemented in the Kimberley by the Department of Finance's Aboriginal Business Capability Program, which commenced in 2020. Morrkul is a registered Not for Profit.

2. KPP BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

Location: Broome and Perth offices

Product: Management and HR consultancy providing high-level strategic assistance – primarily for larger businesses, rather than SMEs.

Pricing: Fee for service

Operation: Kimberley wide and beyond and provides strategic planning and advice to government and larger corporations

Product: Advocacy and representation for Kununurra business members and operation of the Buy-local program. Hosts regular Business after Hours networking events.

Pricing: Free for members

Operation: Kununurra and Wyndham

Pricing: Free (Federal funding)

Operation: Kimberley wide providing business advice, support, mentoring, training and workshops (in person and online), for new & existing indigenous businesses. IBA for the most part serve Aboriginal clients who already have capacity and capability to build to a SME or larger business. Not focussed on nano/micro businesses.

Product: Microenterprise incubators in remote communities for indigenous mob

Pricing: Free

Operation: Activate entrepreneurship in remote Aboriginal communities by supporting community-led microenterprises that foster health and well-being. Currently 2 specific incubator projects in East Kimberley: Op Shop + Bush Products (Balgo) and Op Shop + Photography Collective (Kalumburu).

Operation: Serves Kimberley wide, but operation is based in Perth, no Kimberley office at present, Aboriginal Tourism Business Member services
